## **Instructions to the candidates**

- i. Examination Halls will be opened 20 minutes prior to the commencement of the examination.
- ii. Candidates should report to the examination hall at least 15 (fifteen) minutes prior to the commencement of the examination.
- iii. Candidates should bring with them their Identity Cards issued by the University / Institute, while coming to the Examination.
- iv. Candidates will not be allowed to enter in the examination hall, five minutes after commencement of the examination.
- v. Candidates will not be allowed to leave the examination hall during first hour after starting the examination and during last ten minutes before the end of examination.
- vi. Candidates are forbidden from taking any material into the examination hall, which can be used for malpractice.
- vii. Candidates are prohibited to write anything other than the enrolment number on the question paper (in the place provided for).
- viii. Candidates resorting to the malpractice may lead to cancelling the performance of whole examination, in which case they will have to repeat the entire activities of the semester on additional payment of fees or rustication from the University, as per the Ordinances.
- ix. To ensure conduct of University examinations as per norms, vigilance squads will be appointed. Such vigilance squad shall be authorized to detect use of malpractices and unfair means in the University Examination, by physical check, if necessary. In case of female candidates, the physical check shall be made by the lady member of the squad in complete privacy.
- x. No request for any special concession such as a change in the schedule of Examinations, change in Examination Centre / Hall etc. will be considered on any ground.
- xi. Candidates should see the Notice Board at the place of their examination / Institute / College / School regularly for communication / information / instructions, if any, which may be notified and shall strictly abide by them.
