Unfair Means Activities and Punishments

It is brought to the notice of all the students that as per the Examination Ordinances, 2023, following activities during the examinations would amount to unfair means and punishments provided against each of them are provided for the students involved in unfair means.

Therefore students are communicated not to be involved in any of the unfair means activities.

Activities/behaviour amounting to unfair means

1. Carrying with or in possession of copying material in the form of written, printed, stored in electronic gadget like mobile phone, smart watch, iPad etc. in the examination hall

OR

2. writing or scribing on the question paper, clothes, body part, articles etc.

OR

3. Disclosing the identity of the student on the answer book with any mark etc.

OR

4. Talking with other examinees during the examinations, exchanging answer book, supplement, question paper or copying from each other's answer book, supplement etc.

OR

5. Mischievous behaviour, making noise, causing disturbance in examination hall.

OK

6. Writing in provocative or abusive language and threatening in the answer book

OR

7. Tampering with or tearing of own or other examinee's answer book pages

OR

8. Impersonation at examination

Punishment for the unfair means

Performance of the whole semester (all courses) is cancelled, even if student has found to have involved in unfair means at any one time or one examination.

When the Whole Performance of the student is cancelled (WPC), he/she will not be allowed for ensuing makeup and/or Summer Term Examination, as the case may be.

Such students may appear for next odd/even semester examinations, as backlog student.

The student who is found to have been involved in unfair means in Odd Semester Examination and awarded the punishment of WPC, will not be eligible for registration/admission for the ensuing even semester.

Similarly, if a student is awarded a WPC in the Even Semester End Examination, he/she will not be eligible for admission to the next year. Even if a student achieves a CGPA of 4.50 or above, they will not be promoted to the next year, if they receive a WPC.
